The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 25.03.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 306, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Sherpur, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Heard.

Status report has been received which transpires that charge under Section 306 IPC has been framed. However earlier, the police submitted cancellation report after conducting and completion of the enquiry. The same was not accepted by the learned magistrate vide his order dated 09.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) and further, took the cognizance of the matter and accordingly, issued non-bailable warrants of arrest to the accused. In pursuance thereof, petitioner was arrested in December, 2017.

This court has also gone through the suicide note. Petitioner is the wife of the deceased. Her liability is debatable.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that petitioner is a woman and having kids in her house and that the conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Baljit Kaur wife of Gian Singh is admitted to bail subject to the conditions if any imposed by the trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
