As per office report, process fee has not been filed.

However, learned State counsel states that FIR has been registered against Kala Singh-petitioner No.2. Learned State counsel also filed reply by way of affidavit of Jagdish Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.

As per date of birth certificate (Annexure R-1/T), Mangljeet Kaur-petitioner No.1 born on 22.11.2000. Accordingly, she attained majority on 22.11.2018. Father of Balbir Singh-petitioner No.1 suffered a statement on 22.11.2018 before the police authorities along with his wife that they will not pose any threat to the life of the petitioners.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such. However, in future, if the petitioner feels threat to their life, they may approach concerned Senior Superintendent of Police.
