Reply by way of affidavit dated 11.07.2018 of Sh. Gurtej Singh Sandhu, PPS, DSP Sub Division, Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 (State of Punjab) is taken on record.

Heard.

After 26.05.2017 order (Annexure P-3), petitioner has moved one more bail application before the Sessions Court and it was rejected on 09.05.2018. No doubt this Court in CRM-M-2539-2018, while deciding the matter made an observation that second bail application is not permissible/maintainable. At the same time as long as 09.05.2018 order (Annexure P-7) passed by the Sessions Court is not cancelled or modified with reference to existence of the order dated 26.05.2017, petitioner is not entitled to the relief sought in the present petition. In view of these facts

and circumstances, petitioner has not made out a case.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach Sessions Court insofar as order dated 09.05.2018. If the Sessions Court modifies the order dated 09.05.2018, thereafter, if the order dated 26.05.2017 stands restored in the eye of law, in that event petitioner is permitted to approach this Court for implementation.
