Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No. 482 dated 26.11.2014 under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station "A" Division, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that recovery against the petitioner has been fabricated. She further submits that the petitioner is in custody after re-arrest since 04.01.2017 and the trial is yet to start.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bikramjit Singh, submits that recovery of 270 grams of diphenoxylate has been effected, the commercial of which is 50 grams. However, he has admitted that trial is yet to start because even challan has not been framed, so far.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
