The petitioner Abdul Rashid @ Kalu seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No. 71 dated 04.04.2018 under Section 13 (3) of Haryana Gauvansh Sarankashan and Gau Samvardhan Act and Section 379, 411 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bahin District Palwal.

The allegations against the petitioner are that the police received a secret information to the effect that Abdul Rashid @ Kalu had gone to village Maluka by loading cow beef on a stolen motorcycle and that in case if a raid is conducted he could be arrested. Upon receipt of said information, nakabandi was conducted by the police and a person coming on motorcycle was apprehended who disclosed his name as Abdul Rashid @ Kalu. Upon asking, the said person Abdul Rashid @ Kalu could not produce any document with regard to the ownership/registration of motorcycle in question. He was also found to be carrying 80 kg of cow beef, which was taken into possession by the police.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel.

Learned State counsel has stated that challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been behind bars since the last about three months. No useful purpose would be served by further detaining him in judicial custody. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time. The present petition, as such, is allowed. The petitioner Abdul Rashid @ Kalu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
