The grievance of the petitioner is that despite FIR No. 0090, dated 08.04.2017, having been registered at Police Station Division No. 5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC, the investigation has not been taken to its logical conclusion, more than one year later.

In respect of her grievance, the petitioner is shown to have made a representation to respondent no. 2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-6 with the petition).

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no. 2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to go into the matter and to take appropriate action, as per law, on the representation of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
