The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Balbir Singh Nihang in case FIR No.186 dated 18.10.2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 307, 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied upon the statement of PW-2 Karam Singh. Petitioner along with his associates armed with deadly weapons came to the spot and attacked on the other party and they shot dead Baljit Singh. The trial is at the final stage. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is also instituted a cross-case that shall be considered.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this court does not find it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail.

Petition is dismissed.
