This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.c. by Ritika Arora complainant in case FIR No.16 dated 09.03.2018 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'IPC') with a prayer to respondent No.2 to look into the FIR and take the requisite action.
