Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.122 dated 29.10.2010 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 326, 323, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran as well as judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 11.07.2016 passed by learned JMIC, Patti (P-2) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 05.02.2018 (Annexures P-3).

2. Pursuant to order dated 18.05.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 18.07.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.137, dated 21.07.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, vide Endst. No.38879 dated 23.07.2018.

3. According to the report, learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is without any pressure, threat or promise on the part of anyone.
4. Considering the report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, dated 21.07.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.122 dated 29.10.2010 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 326, 323, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran as well as judgment dated 11.07.2016 passed by learned JMIC, Patti vide which the petitioners were convicted under Sections 326, 323, 34 IPC (P-2), is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.
5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
6. List on 14.11.2018, for production of receipt with regard to deposit of aforesaid costs.
