Prayer in this petition is for quashing of orders dated 22.05.2014 (Annexure P1), 03.05.2014 (Annexure P2) and 24.04.2014 (Annexure P3), vide which the trial Court has declined to examine the witnesses of the petitioner/complainant at the stage of pre-charge evidence.

The parties are *ad idem* that since the charges have been framed by the trial Court, this petition, at this stage, has become infurcutous.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be granted liberty to withdraw this petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the trial Court in case examination of witnesses is required at the stage of post-charge evidence.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case, any such application is filed, the trial Court will decide the same in accordance with law without prejudice by the impugned orders that such permission was not granted at the stage of pre-charge evidence.
