Petitioner Amandeep Singh @ Amna has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.5 dated 11.01.2015, registered at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, under Sections 307, 353, 186, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petitioner was on regular bail and he was appearing regularly before the trial Court. He absented himself from the Court proceedings only on one date i.e. 05.12.2017.

The petitioner has been in custody since 16.01.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
