On the last date the following order was passed :-

“Counsel for the appellants No.2 and 3 states that despite having written letters, the appellants No.2 & 3 had not contacted him to inform him about the LRs of appellant No.1 who was their brother and prays for one last opportunity of one week to do the needful.

Allowed as prayed for.

Adjourned to 13.12.2018. Last opportunity of one week is granted.”

Even today Counsel for appellants No. 2 and 3 states that none has contacted him. Counsel for the respondent has stated that the appeal cannot be decided in the absence of appellant No.1. Counsel for the appellants No. 2 and 3 is not in a position to deny this fact. In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed as having been abated.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
