The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.520 dated 06.12.2014, under Section 22/29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that perusal of FIR it is evident that recovery is from one Manjit Singh whereas petitioner is only owner of the vehicle and recovery is not from the car of the petitioner. It is also submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, which is not objected by the State counsel, especially having regard to the fact that petitioner is not involved in any other case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Gurpreet Singh is

ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
