Petitioners have approached this Court alleging threats to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8 or any other person at their behest and, therefore, have prayed that apart from these persons, no other person may also be allowed to interfere in their peaceful living as husband and wife as they have performed marriage on 17.05.2018 as per the Sikh rites and rituals at Gurudwara Dashmesh Pita Patshahi Dasvi (Regd.) Village Singa Devi, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali (Punjab). Direction is sought from this Court for protection of life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8 on this pretext that the marriage is not solemnized with the consent of the family members of petitioner No. 1.

When the case was taken up for hearing, Mr. Gagandeep Singh Manku, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 7- Nishan Singh son of Swaran Singh and has submitted his power of attorney. Initially, a request was made that respondent No. 7, who is the paternal uncle of petitioner No. 1, wanted to talk to petitioner No. 1, which was accepted. After he had talked with petitioner No. 1, counsel, on his

instructions, states that none of the private respondents want to have any relations with petitioner No. 1 or petitioner No. 2 and he further states that they would not, in any manner, interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, the present petition is disposed of in the light of the statement of counsel for respondent No. 7 with directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O. Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps, in accordance with law and ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized in any manner.
