Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 not to interfere in the life of the petitioner.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioner is major and she does not want to reside her paternal uncle's (*Taau*) family as she is treated as a servant and she is not allowed to continue her studies.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP, Head Quarter, Panipat, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per the reply, respondent Nos. 4 and 5 have made a statement before the police that the petitioner is a student of M.Sc. (Maths) at Murthal University and she has left her house on 17.05.2018 for her University. It is also stated that an FIR bearing No. 0303 dated 19.05.2018, under Section 365 of the IPC has been registered against respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered infructuous, at

this stage. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case she faces any threat to her life and liberty in future, it will be open for her to approach the Court again.
