Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 09.04.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 453, 441, 452, 406 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Vide order dated 25.05.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner was granted interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that pursuant to the order dated 25.05.2018, petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has been admitted on interim bail, the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant. He refers to compromise deed dated 10.10.2018 which is placed on record in the connected petition i.e. CRM-M-27684-2018 titled as Ashok Kumar Versus

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant does not dispute the factum of compromise, rather fairly concedes that the matter has been resolved between the parties.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.05.2018 whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail is made absolute.
