Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.0136, dated 23.11.2016(Annexure P-1), registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 20.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 02.06.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 16.06.2017 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, SAS Nagar (Mohali), has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.201, dated 01.05.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, vide Endst. No.4810, dated 04.05.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, SAS Nagar (Mohali), is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with

their free will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali), dated 01.05.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.0136, dated 23.11.2016(Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹8,000/- shall be deposited with the following account:-
