Petitioner has approached this Court alleging harassment at the hands of SHO, Police Station, Sadar Patti, Tarn Taran on the pretext that son-in-law of the petitioner is alleged to have been involved in some criminal case and it is to trace him of that various raids are being conducted at the residence of the petitioner and he is, time and again, called to the police station and kept sitting there.

On considering the petition and the prayer made therein, it is ordered that in case, the presence of the petitioner is required, proper notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. be given to him. The mandate of the Statute requires to be fulfilled for the said purpose.
