ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.220 dated 28.02.2018 under Sections 279/336/307 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act, Section 13 (1) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that allegations in the FIR are that the petitioners were travelling in a truck which was carrying 21 bullocks and there is no allegation against them that they had fired a shot or caused any fire arm injury. The petitioners are in custody for almost two months since their arrest on 28.02.2018.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwan Singh, states that investigation has been completed and the matter is now listed for framing of charges.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners were found to be merely sitting in the vehicle which was carrying 21 bullocks. They are in custody for almost two months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to both the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Both the petitioners, namely Rasid and Sartaj, are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
