The petitioner seeks quashing of complaint No. 250 dated 20.3.2017 under Sections 145, 146 and 147 of Railways Act, 1989.

During course of arguments, the petitioner has submitted that the matter is at the stage of recording of defence evidence and that from the evidence led by the prosecution, it is evident that a false case had been registered on the basis of testimonies of the official witnesses. The petitioner has further pointed out several discrepancies in the statement of the witnesses of the complainant including the discrepancies as regards the time of arrest.

Having heard the petitioner, I find that the aforesaid discrepancies in statement of the witnesses of the complainant can be better appreciated during the course of trial especially, since the trial is stated to be virtually at its fag end.

In view of the above stated position, the petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the points raised herein this petition before the learned trial Court. Needless to mention that the trial Court shall take into account all the submissions as well as the discrepancies pointed out by the petitioner while deciding the case.
