Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.56 dated 17.03.2018 registered under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kalanwali.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not apprehended at the spot and is named in the FIR on the basis of the disclosure statement.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Mahesh Kumar, has submitted that a perusal of the FIR show that the co-accused – Manpreet Singh @ Nikka was arrested at the spot and informed the Investigating Officer that he has purchased the weapon from the present petitioner three months before registration of the FIR for a sum of Rs.20,000/-. It is further submitted that the petitioner is involved in 02 other cases i.e. one under the NDPS Act and the other under the Arms Act and, therefore, the petitioner is a habitual offender.

In view of same, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
