The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to conduct proper investigation in FIR No.266 dated 12.04.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Gurugram.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the private respondent despite the application dated 24.02.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the said complaint dated 24.02.2018 should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the application of the petitioner within a period of 06 weeks, on receipt of

certified copy of this order. Let three copies of the petition be served upon him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the application dated 24.02.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
