ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is, inter-alia, seeking a direction to the Bureau of Investigation to inquire into the allegations levelled by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner, who is an NRI, had invested a sum of ₹80 lacs for a residential flat. However, it later transpired that the petitioner had been cheated. The allotment of the flat has not been made to him till date.

Learned counsel confines his prayer to issuance of a direction to respondent No.4-Inspector General of Police, NRI Wing, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the complaint of the petitioner dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take action, in accordance with law. The prayer of the petitioner appears to be reasonable. Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the complaint dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law.
