The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.141 dated 03.05.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Daba District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

In this case, the recovery of the contraband has been effected from the premises/shop of the petitioner which falls within commercial quantity.

To the mind of this Court, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary. Therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
