The petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of protection to them and also issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take remedial action on the complaints submitted by them against the excess and commission of criminal offences which prima facie makes out a cognizable offence against respondent Nos.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P-1), moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, by the petitioners be considered and decided in a time bound manner.

In view of above, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and decide the same expeditiously preferably within 60 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
