In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.173 dated 25.06.2017, under Sections 307, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Rania District Sirsa (Haryana).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 26.06.2017 and the complainant has been examined. Therefore, petitioner is entitled for regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid dates and events.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially having regard to the fact that petitioner is in custody since

26.06.2017 therefore, question of custodial interrogation is also not attracted and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jasvinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
