The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry into the complaint dated 28.03.2018.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the private respondent despite the complaint dated 28.03.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the said complaint dated 28.03.2018 should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mrs. Anju Arora, Addl. AG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the complaint of the petitioner within a period of 08 weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let three copies of the petition be served upon her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the complaint dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
