Prayer in this petition is for setting-aside the order dated 29.01.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal, on a revision petition preferred by the petitioner alongwith three others, namely, Gurtej, Deepak and Darshan qua whom the revision petition was accepted but with regard to the petitioner the said petition was dismissed. The revision petition was preferred, challenging the order dated 18.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kaithal, whereby, after recording the statement of the complainant, all these four persons were summoned as additional accused on an application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C. A perusal of the FIR as well as the statement of the complainant would show that the petitioner has been attributed a specific injury with a particular weapon, which has a corresponding injury. The order dated 29.01.2018, as has been

passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal, cannot be faulted with.

The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

Any observation made herein above shall have no bearing on the merits of the case during the trial or in the ultimate decision to be taken by the Court in any manner and any observation is for the purpose of decision of the present revision only.
