This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.114 dated 24.04.2016, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 04.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the petitioner and respondent No.2-complainant.

On 18.01.2018, following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner has not put in appearance nor has anyone put in appearance for respondent No.2. Report of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chandigarh, dated 23.10.2017 indicates that although the accused-petitioner had appeared before the Court but the

complainant, despite being summoned, had not put in appearance as his house always found to be closed. Even the accused could not bring the complainant to Court to substantiate the contention with regard to the compromise dated 04.10.2016. It is also not intimated as to whether the petitioner has deposited a sum of ₹ 10,000/-, which was required to be deposited.

Since the counsel for the petitioner is not present, in the interest of justice, hearing of the case is deferred to **20.02.2018.”**

Thereafter, the case has been listed on two occasions. None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the compromise has not finally been materialized, which is the reason that the petitioner's counsel or that of respondent No.2 are not present today as well.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
