Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Pawan @ Monti in case arising from FIR No.121 dated 18.03.2017 registered under Sections 20 and 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat.

According to the prosecution recovery of 39 grams of Ganja, 06 grams of smack and 16 grams of charas was effected from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The quantity of the contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial. The petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2017 The conclusion of trial will take a long time.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the bail application.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without

expression any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed.

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Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
