The petitioner is seeking quashing of criminal complaint No.15564 of 2012 (Annexure P-3) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including summoning order dated 21.05.2012 (Annexure P-4) and the proclamation order dated 14.07.2014 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the legally available pleas before the trial Court; during trial. However, it is further submitted that personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court be exempted.

Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection, if the present petition is permitted to be withdrawn.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

So far as, personal exemption of the petitioner before the trial Court is concerned, the petitioner would be at liberty to make an application

before the trial Court. In case, any application to this effect is made, the trial Court shall consider the same sympathetically.

Since the complaint is of the year 2012 and it has not been finally decided so far, therefore, it would not be unjustified if the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial itself; within a time bound manner.

Hence, it is directed that the trial of the case itself would be completed by the trial Court within a period of four months from the next date fixed before it.
