The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 23.4.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324, 452 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

It is the allegation against the petitioner that on 19.4.2018 at about 9:30 p.m., the petitioner armed with datar entered the house of the complainant in drunkard condition and he caused simple hurt.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhram Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required

for further investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 21.5.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
