This is a petitioner that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate direction for the representation dated 20.03.2018 to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect and ensure the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family.

In brief, the facts are that the petitioners herein got FIR No.03 dated 06.02.2018 registered under Sections 376, 506 of IPC against respondent No. 4- Karan Sharma, who was eventually arrested on 09.03.2018, the said accused was granted regular bail on 09.03.2018 under Section 439 Cr.P.C..

It is submitted that after release from jail, the said accused has been harassing the petitioner herein, which necessitated the filing of an application dated 12.03.2018 for taking appropriate legal action against him

and others.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a threat perception and protection be allowed.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P.Chahar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of four weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

In case there is a threat perception as provided by the petitioner, necessary action be taken thereof.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms
