In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.205 dated 06.09.2017 under Sections 420/467/468/120-B IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar, Panipat, District Panipat.

2. This Court vide order dated 22.05.2018 granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigation Officer and petitioner was directed abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation. The observation made in order dated 22.05.2018 remain unrebutted.

4. In view of these factual aspect, order dated 22.5.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. He shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
