Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that they are not being allowed to enter the village by the Sarpanch and Panches of Village Jamsher Khas, Jalandhar. Highlighting the said grievance, it has been stated by the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have approached the police authorities through a representation dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) but despite that till date, nothing has been done. He further states that the petitioners were earlier involved in some criminal case, in which they have been acquitted and till date, there is no other case registered or pending against the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4- Station House Officer, Police Station, Jamsher Khas, Jalandhar, to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Station House Officer, Police Station, Jamsher Khas, Jalandhar-

Respondent No.4, to look into the representation dated 20.04.2018

(Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law,
if required.
