In the present petition, petitioner seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.45 dated 07.03.2018 under Sections 341, 323, 295, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Ludhiana.

2. This Court vide order dated 31.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 31.05.2018 petitioner has joined investigation. Petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 31.05.2018,

granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
