MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

This petition has been filed by accused, namely, Rajesh for issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos.2 to 5 to protect his life and liberty as well as of his family members. The petitioner is presently confined in District Jail, Gurugram and is facing trial in many cases for serious offences. The contents of the petition also reveal this fact about involvement of the petitioner in pending criminal cases. The petitioner has further relied upon order dated 07.09.2017 (Annexure P-2) whereby the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtak, accepted his application for providing proper security to the accused while producing him before the Court.

The State has also filed the reply by way of affidavit of Jashandeep Randhawa, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Rohtak informing that in case the security is provided to hard core criminals, the same is likely to be misused and terrify the general public. There are nine number of cases

which are pending against the petitioner and the detail is furnished. The petitioner also stands convicted in some of the cases and serving the sentence as well.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the order already passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtak, no ground for issuance of directions is made out.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
