The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 21.03.2018 under Section 174-A of the IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar, Sonapat.

2. This Court vide order dated 24.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilawar Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 24.05.2018 the petitioner has joined investigation. That apart observations made by this Court in the order dated 24.05.2018 have gone un rebutted.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 24.05.2018, granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. The petition stands allowed accordingly.
