Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 54 dated 03.08.2017, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Satnampura, Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel submits that the recovery effected from the petitioner is of commercial quantity and out of total seven prosecution witnesses, one witness has been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his argument to the extent that a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously as the petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.08.2017.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months from today.
