The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.633 dated 18.09.2017, registered under Sections 324/452/506/64 (307 added later on) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat.

2. The petitioner was not specifically named in the original FIR. He has remained in detention for more than three months now.
