This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code ('Cr.P.C.' - for short) for grant of regular bail in FIR No.040 dated 09.03.2018 under Section 379-B and 411 IPC (added later) registered at Police Station Phase 1, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has not named in the FIR, he is in custody since 12.03.2018 and challan has already been presented on 09.05.2018. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has duly acknowledged the above

factual position on instructions from HC Raj Kumar.

Heard both sides.

The custody period of the petitioner has not been disputed by State counsel. Since the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and the final report has been filed in Court. The trial will take a long time as charges are yet to be framed in this case.

Consequently, this Court is of the view that it would be just and appropriate if the concession of bail is granted to the petitioner. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Sahil Chabbra be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
