Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to give advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioners for calling them to the police station for the purpose of conducting enquiry in the complaint given by respondent No.5.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala filed in the Court today, is taken on record. As per this reply, respondent No.5 had earlier filed a complaint, which was enquired by the DSP. Thereafter, another complaint was filed by respondent No.5, which was again enquired by the SHO, Police Station Samrala and it was found that the subject matter of the second complaint is similar to the earlier complaint given by respondent No.5. It is further stated that as per the enquiry, the dispute is found to be of civil nature and a civil suit is already pending between the parties and therefore, no police action is required. Copies of the reports are attached with this reply as Annexures R-1/T to R-3/T.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous.
