Respondent No.2-Sukhcahin Kaur has stated that no compromise had taken place between her and her husband Jagshir Singh @ Jagsir Singh. She has made a statement that since her husband Jagshir Singh @ Jagsir Singh has contracted a second marriage, she is not bound by the compromise and she is not willing to give her consent for cancellation of the FIR.

Hearing the statement, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition granting him liberty to take recourse to the other remedies available to him under law.

Allowed.
