The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.56 dated 26.3.2014 registered for the offences punishable under Section 420 Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sector 19, Chandigarh.

Heard.

It is a case of jumping of bail as he could not appear the Court on the date fixed. Now, the petitioner has joined the proceedings.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 2.6.2017 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;

- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
