Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1, appeared in the Court and prayed for having a meeting with petitioner No.1.

The matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre for arranging a meeting between them and to record the statement of petitioner No.1.

As per statement recorded by the Mediator, it is stated by petitioner No.1 that she is aged about 19 years and has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 without any pressure and with her own free will and against the wishes of her parents and she wants to stay with petitioner No.2.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievance of petitioners.

It is made clear that nothing is observed by this Court with regard to validity of the said marriage and in case, any FIR is registered against petitioner No.2, the police is at liberty to take appropriate legal action in accordance with law.
