Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.154 dated 10.04.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon an affidavit of complainant (Annexure P-4). He has also drawn attention of the Court to the order dated 04.05.2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jagadhari directing the petitioner to hand over a copy of the affidavit to the Investigating Officer, who would inquire into the matter and submit a report. However, while passing the impugned order, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jagadhari has not referred to the report submitted by the Investigating Officer on the genuineness of the affidavit dated 14.02.2017

Without further commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed.

Original affidavit dated 14.02.2017 duly notarized by Notary Public has been handed over to ASI Ved Pal in the Court.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail by the Investigating Officer on furnishing bail bond to his satisfaction. Petitioner would join the investigation as and when called upon.

This order shall remain operative till filing of the challan and thereafter the petitioner would be at liberty to move a fresh application before the learned trial Court.
