By this petition, the petitioner seeks permission to travel abroad to the United Kingdom between 24.5.2018 till 10.6.2018 and thereafter to travel to Vancouver, Canada, till 18.6.2018, the reason being that her daughter is stated to be an actress, who has to shoot for a movie abroad.

It is seen that the petitioner is arraigned as an accused in FIR No.120, registered at Police Station Malour Sadar, District Muktsar, on 17.9.2010, with her having been admitted to bail by this Court vide an order passed on 22.10.2010 in CRM-M-29580 of 2010 (copy Annexure P-2).

Notice having been issued in this petition, Mr.V.G.Jauhar, Sr.DAG, Punjab, could not dispute (on instruction) that the concession of bail has never been misused by the petitioner.

In view of the above and the dispute stated to be between immediate family, with no comment made whatsoever by this Court as regards the dispute itself in respect of which the FIR has been registered, with the petitioner wanting to travel abroad for a limited period, this petition

is disposed of with the petitioner permitted to travel abroad between 26.5.2018 to 30.6.2018 (as submitted by learned Senior Counsel).

Naturally, if she misuses the concession of bail or does not return within time, the respondent State or the aggrieved party would be at liberty to file for cancellation of bail.

Obviously, the petitioner would only travel abroad if she has a valid visa to do so.

Since the petitioner is to travel the day after tomorrow, a copy of this order be given to learned counsel for the petitioner, under the signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
