Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for entrusting investigation qua torture and sexual assault to the petitioner by illegally detaining her in police custody from 21.04.2017 to 23.04.2017. She was booked in FIR No.129, dated 23.04.2017 registered under Sections 380/457 IPC, at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hisar.

According to the petitioner, she was taken into custody illegally on 21.04.2017 by the police officials of CIA Police Station, Hansi and given mercilessly beatings after removing her clothes. Even a stick was tried to be put in her private parts forcibly. She was tortured brutally by the police officials namely Vikas, Naresh and their two companions. The petitioner was also abused in the name of her caste and finally booked in FIR No.129, dated 23.04.2017 under Sections 380/457 IPC falsely, to save their skin.

Heard.

Considering seriousness of the allegations against the police officials of CIA Staff, Hansi, the matter is referred to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hisar, for investigating into the allegations of the petitioner against the police officials of CIA Staff, Hansi, personally or to get the same investigated from a senior officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police under his supervision and shall pass a speaking order after hearing the petitioner within two months positively from the date of receipt of this order.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
