Counsel for the State furnished status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Varinder Pal Singh, Inspector SHO, Police Station Ladowal, District Ludhiana on behalf of State of Punjab. The same is taken on record. Perusal of para 3 of the affidavit, it is evident that petitioner is a habitual offender having regard to the fact that he is involved in 5 FIRs. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that co-accused of the petitioner has been extended the benefit of bail. Co-accused status cannot be compared with the petitioner.

At this juncture, counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner be permitted to surrender before the Trial Court and seek bail before the Trial Court. Accordingly, petitioner is permitted to surrender before the Trial Court and seek further relief, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
