2.) On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners is hereby directed to furnish 3 sets of the paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day. Service of notice to respondent Nos.4 and 5 is dispensed as no adverse order is being passed against the said respondents.

3.) In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for a direction to the official respondents to consider their representation dated 19.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur by which they are seeking protection of their life and liberty. Petitioners are stated to have fell in love with each other and taken a decision to marry each other after attaining marriageable age. Undisputedly

2nd petitioner is aged about 17 ½ years. Petitioners presume that there is a threat to their life and liberty from the members of the family and other relatives. In this regard, petitioners have submitted representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur dated 19.05.2018 (Annexure P-3). In view of these facts and circumstances, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur – respondent No.2 is hereby directed to examine the petitioners' representation dated 19.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and consider their grievance at the earliest.

4.) Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
